During the month of December, we are implementing the state and central government schemes such as AMRUT and SBM.

We aspire to state that the municipality declared as ODF city On 2nd Oct 2016 by QCI. During the month of December we made an extraordinary efforts to recover the unpaid taxes and collected an amount of 1,20,00000 as never before. Feasibility surveys have conducted for water supply and Septage Management under AMRUT. And also the work orders of Amrut Parks have been issued and the work will be grounded soon. Our Municipality has started implementing e-office as per the orders of MAUD. A special drive has been conducted by chairperson against plastic use in the municipality.

Special Drive against Plastic use

The Municipality launched special drives on 20th December 2016. Sanitary inspectors were inspected shops at different localities and seized the plastic covers, and also warned the shopkeepers who are using the restricted bags. Chairperson stated that the municipality will impose penalty and takes a severe action in such case. Also conducted awareness among the public and asked the people to avoid the plastic bags and suggested them to go for the paper/jute bags.



Road Widening

The Municipality has decided to widen the four major roads in the town and making strategies for the further actions. As a part of this, surveyor along with TPS conducted a survey and stated that, the municipality is planning to widen 11 meters on the both sides of the existing road. Commissioner conducted a meeting with the affected land owners who are opposing the activity. Negotiations are going on with affected people.



Awareness programs on cashless Transactions



A formal meeting held in Municipal Commissioner Chamber along with Canara bank manager Mr. Prabhakar regarding Cashless Transactions, e-pos machines and digital literacy. Mr. Prabhakar discussed the importance of cashless transactions. Municipal Commissioner formed ward wise committees in association with janmabhoomi committee members, SHG's etc. In that meeting, it was decided that with the help of committee members, every family should open a Jandhan account and should be provided with Rupay cards.

Meeting On Regularization of Unauthorized structures

The commissioner along with chairperson conducted a meeting with citizens and pointed out the violators who are obstructing the Govt building rules. And they've alerted them that if the enforcement teams will visit the town, they will demolish the constructions of such kind. Chairperson advised them to regularize their buildings through online BPS facility.

Council Meeting

Council meeting held on 30th December 2016, came up with 30 agendas. Major works approved in meeting are

- Up gradation of existing roads within the municipality with an estimated cost of 20,80,000/-.

AMRUT

The work orders of AMRUT parks 2015-16 has been issued to the contractor Mr .Kishore Chakravarthy , the work will be grounded shortly.

Town planning – Online Building Approvals

Online building approval system has been started from 31st march 2016. Up to the month of December we have received 158 applications in which 111 got approved. Revenue generated through online applications is 55,01,916/-.

Revenue Section

During the demonetization situation, the Govt issued orders to accept the old currency notes in municipal offices. So the municipal dept formed a special team by involving RI's and Bill collectors under the supervision of Asst commissioner to mobilize the citizens of the town, and collected nearly 1,20,00000/-by December itself.
